All dogs must be 6 months of age to enter. All tests will simulate situations one may encounter in a hunting situation. Dogs will be evaluated based upon the rules set forth by GRCA to determine that the dog has displayed those abilities in a hunting retriever.

Training will not be allowed on the grounds until after the finish of both stakes.

This event will be held under the rules of GRCA. It is the handler's responsibility to be knowledgeable of the rules by which this test is run. Copies are available from the GRCA's website. www.grca.com

Bitches in season or injured dogs may be scratched any time prior to 8:00 AM on the day of the test by contacting the test secretary. There will be a \$20 charge for scratches after the entry close to cover the cost of birds and other event expenses. Entries not scratched for cause prior to 8:00 AM on the test day will be considered to be no shows and no refunds will be given.

Running Order

Running order will be decided by draw. Handlers are responsible for checking in with the marshal and having dogs ready when called. Late dogs will be eliminated from further competition. The stake will be held open for 15 minutes after the last available dog has run.

Courses and Birds

WC: Test consists of a double marked retrieve on land and two single marked retrieves on water. Dogs may be brought to

the line on leash and may be gently restrained until sent to retrieve and must deliver to hand. Leashes, including short tabs must be removed before sending the dog to retrieve.

WCX: Test consists of a triple marked land retrieve and a double marked water retrieve.

Ducks will be used on water retrieves. Ducks, pigeons, or pheasant may be used on land retrieves depending on availability.
